RADIO BROADCASTING OF SDHSAA STATE EVENTS

There will be no charge for broadcasting all or any part of the SDHSAA State Tournaments. We must know ahead of the tournaments whether your station expects to broadcast. Whether your station is connected with a "Tournament Network" or not, we still want to hear from each individual station. Stations are responsible for hook-up costs.

The radio station agrees:

1. To announce or broadcast any SDHSAA public service announcements given to the radio station.
2. That there will be **no** advertising of gambling, alcoholic beverages or tobacco during the broadcasts of the tournament games. It is not necessary to submit a list of sponsors and the product or products to be advertised. However, any violation of the gambling/alcohol/tobacco regulation will make this contract void and the station will not be allowed to continue its broadcast of the tournament.
3. The announcers will confine their remarks to an actual description of the games and the action in connection with them, and that announcers will make no comments in regard to the judgement of game officials or coaches during any broadcast originating from the tournament site. Violation of this clause will make this contract void and as above, the station will not be allowed to continue its broadcast of the tournament.
4. That in case there is not enough space to accommodate all stations requesting space that the space will be assigned in the order in which applications are received with those radio stations planning to cover all games being given priority.
5. That after this application has been filed and approved by the SDHSAA, that all arrangements for the installation of lines into the tournament site and similar matters shall be cleared with the person listed below before any instructions are given to the telephone company. **THE TELEPHONE CO. EXPECTS A THREE (3) TO FIVE (5) DAY LEAD TIME FOR INSTALLATION.**
6. That the broadcast will not be "fed" to another station until that station has filed an application and had such application approved by SDHSAA.

STATE FOOTBALL PLAY-OFFS

Telephone lines for the state football playoffs must be activated by the radio station in order to be correctly billed. Stations must contact Derek at Qwest Communications (888-661-0005, ext. 1302330) to set up the line. Stations can give USD Sports information Director Amil Anderson (605-677-5927) as a contact for the installation of the line, but also must contact Anderson to notify him of which games they plan to broadcast. Stations that do not pay for activation of a telephone line ahead of time will not be allowed to broadcast.

Twelve lines are available on press row, with a limit of two people per station (play-by-play announcer and color commentator). Priority will be given to radio stations planning to cover all six final games. We encourage stations getting together to take a "feed" rather than all trying to do individual broadcasts.
