

SDHSAA VISUAL ARTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE – 2017 Minutes

Monday March 31, 2017

10:00am

The meeting was called to order at 10:00am. Committee members in attendance were Kate Witt, Marica Shannon.

Justin Brunick was not in attendance. John Lebeouf arrived at 10:10am. Audience member, Jen Dorn from Hamlin HS, was also in attendance.

The committee reviewed the minutes from the April 18, 2016 meeting.

Marica Shannon motioned to approve the agenda.

Kate Witt Seconded the motion.

The motion passed 2-0

Brooks Bowman reviewed the calendar of Visual Arts Events for 2017-18

- a. Rules meeting due by October 27
- b. Intent to Participate due by December 1
- c. Online registration due by March 1
- d. 2017 State Art Gallery March 15-17, Sioux Falls

The committee discussed the 2017 State Visual Arts Gallery and Competition. The following changes were recommended by the Advisory Committee:

- It was suggested that name cards be printed on adhesive labels that can be attached to ID cards during the check-in process
- It is recommended that website be updated with new hanging examples. The committee members will put together examples and send to Brooks Bowman to be uploaded to the website.
- It is recommended that the template for the artist statement be made 5"x7". The artist statement will remain 5"x5", and the bottom 2 inches will be left for the id card to be attached. Kate Witt will create a new template.
- It was suggested that Brooks Bowman look into options for booths to be set up during the event for Colleges and vendors.

- The committee discussed adding workshops or quick-draw competitions to the visual arts event. Brooks Bowman suggested that the discussion be tabled until 2019.

The committee discussed alternate venue options. The Washington Pavillion was noted as a possible alternate site. The committee decided that the current venues are suitable, but as the number of entries continues to grow, the committee may need to reconsider its venue options.

The committee discussed rotating venues between Class A and Class AA Basketball tournaments

- The committee recommends that, beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, the event move to a rotation of 2 years in Rapid City, 2 years in Sioux Falls, starting with Rapid City in 2020. This rotation will allow the State Art Competition to take place at both the Class AA & the Class A combined Basketball Tournaments.

The committee discussed judges for future Visual Arts Competitions. After much discussion, it was recommended that 3 more judges be hired. Each judge would be assigned to judge 3 categories in all 3 classes all classes. This will significantly reduce the length of time it takes to judge all entries and will help to eliminate judge errors.

John LeBeouf motioned to approve all of the recommendations made in regards to changes in the State Visual Arts Competition. The motion was seconded by Marica Shannon.

The committee discussed potential new judges for future Visual Arts Competitions. Several new names were added to the judge list.

The committee thanked Kate Witt for her years of service on the SDHSAA Visual Arts Advisory Committee. Kate's term ends at the end of the 2016-2017 school year. The SDHSAA will send out an email requesting nominations for a new Class B Representative on the Visual Arts Advisory Committee. The term of this position will be 3 years, ending in the 2019-2020 school year.

Kate Witt motioned to adjourn the meeting at 12:00pm. Marica Shannon seconded the motion.
