

Match Format and Scoring

Outdoors:

Championship round matches	2 out of 3 sets – no add scoring with the use of the 7 point tie-break
3 rd place through 5 th place matches (includes 5 th place semis)	10 game pro-set – no add scoring with the use of the 7 point tie-break
Consolation matches	10 game pro set – no add scoring with the use of the 7 point tie-break

Indoors: Format is subject to change due to weather conditions and will be mutually decided by the Meet Director and SDHSAA.

Note – Additional matches (3rd, 5th, and consolation) may be played indoors as time permits and courts are available.

Championship and consolation rounds (except semi-final & final)	10 game pro set – no add scoring with the use of the 7 point tie-break
Semi-final matches	2 out of 3 sets with a 10 point match tie-break in lieu of the deciding final set
Final matches	2 out of 3 sets – no add scoring with the use of the 7 point tie-break

When moving from indoor back to outdoor tennis, the same format as used indoors will be used until the entire round has been completed at a specific flight.

- For all place matches, points are awarded for each match played and won.
- Additional second round points will be awarded to the winner of the eight matches in the second round of championship play. Players receiving first round byes must win their 2nd round championship match before receiving points for the bye.
- Players receiving a bye in the second round of consolation must win their 3rd round consolation match before receiving points for the consolation bye.
