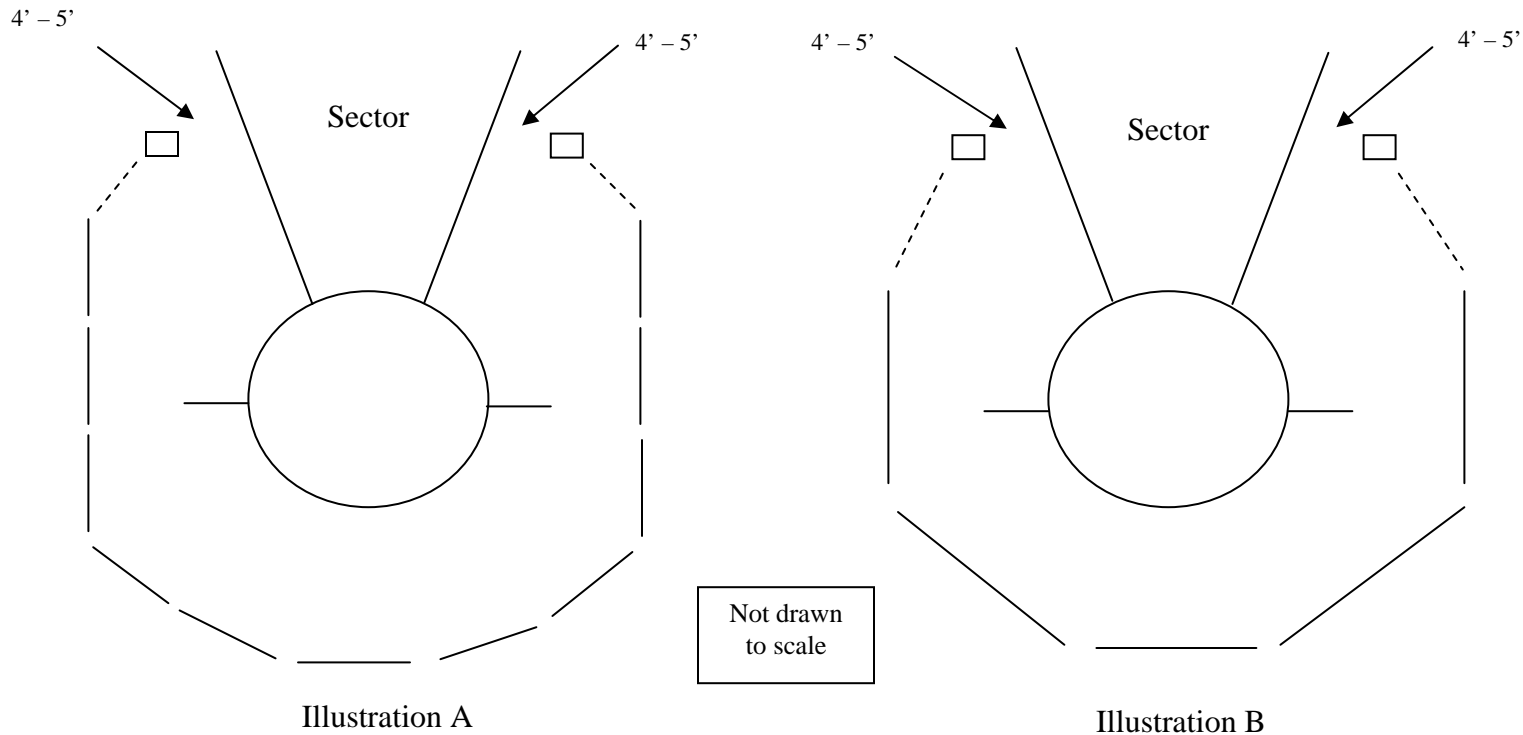


## Discus Cage Illustration



- Represents new post added 4' to 5' from sector line
- Solid line – existing fence
- - - - - New section of fence

### Discus Reminders:

1. There must be a rear to the cage as well as sides that extend forward at least to the front of the ring.
2. The ends of the cage (wing/gate pole) should be placed near enough to the sector lines to maintain a 4 to 5 feet relationship in distance from the lines.
3. Illustration A: The existing cage is past the front of the circle. Add a corner post and “fencing” material so the post is 4' to 5' from the sector line.
4. Illustration B: The existing cage is just even with the front of the circle. Extend with a new section or sections with a new post to within 4' to 5' of the sector line.
5. The cage extensions beyond the front of the ring are not mandatory – just highly recommended.
