Title of Proposal: State Gymnastics Team Day Rotation Seeding

Proposal will affect the following classes (please check all that apply):

- Class B
- Class A
- Class AA

### Proposed Rule Change:

Rotation order for the Team Day Competition would be set based on ranking by team score at Qualifying Region meet. Assignments would follow Olympic order (Vault, Bars, Beam, Floor). First rotation would have teams ranked 2/4/6/8 starting on respective events. Second rotation would have teams ranked 1/3/5/7. Attached is a sample rotation.

### Rationale for Rule Change:

Olympic rotation order is the universally recognized preferred rotation. Seeding rotation assignments versus random draw would award teams for Region scores. This is similar to what is done with preferred lane assignments in track. This would also group similarly ranked teams so judges are seeing those teams within a closer timeframe to allow for a more accurate comparison.
