

## SDHSAA VISUAL ARTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE – 2022 AGENDA

1. Call meeting to order  
Brooks Bowman called the meeting to order at 4:03pm. Committee members present were Dana Schuldt, Chad Nelson, and Mandy DeWitt.

2. Additions to/approve the agenda  
There were no additions to the agenda.

Mandy Motioned, seconded by Dana, to approve the agenda. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Calendar of Visual Arts Events for 2022-23
  - a. Rules meeting must be completed by October 1
  - b. Intent to Participate due by December 1
  - c. Online registration due by March 1
  - d. 2023 State Art Gallery March 16-18, Rapid City
4. Discuss possible changes for the state contest
  - a. Add language to handbook stating that any student wishing to participate in the SDHSAA Visual Arts Competition must be enrolled in an SDHSAA member school's art class.

Article 3, Section 1 Student Eligibility

A. The SDHSAA Visual Arts Contest is open to students in grades 7-12 **who are enrolled in their school's art class.**

Chad motioned, seconded by Mandy, to approve the change to Article 3, section 1 of the Handbook. The motion passed unanimously.

- b. Require advisors to submit a picture or digital version of their entries when they submit their registration form.

Dana motioned, seconded by Mandy, to require pictures for all art entries to be submitted with the registration form. The motion passed unanimously.

- c. Review all category descriptions and make recommendations for changes.

**Section 2. CATEGORIES:** Twelve categories have been established for the Visual Arts contest. The following are the approved categories that may be used for the State Visual Arts Contest Gallery.

1. **Drawing (Monochromatic):** The Drawing category must be presented in one of the following mediums: Pencil, Charcoal, Ink, and Scratchboard.
2. **Drawing Colored:** The Drawing Colored category must be presented in one of the following mediums: Oil pastels, colored chalks, colored ink, etc.
3. **Painting (Oil and Acrylic):** The Painting category must be presented in one of the following mediums: Oil or Acrylic.
4. **Painting (Watercolor):** The Painting category must be presented in one of the following mediums: Watercolor. Pencil construction lines are allowed; any other added materials not being watercolor, will not be allowed in this category.
5. **Photography:** The Photography category must present a single photograph entry with limited manipulation. Limited manipulation will consist of minor exposure corrections only. Photographs can be digital or non-digital, and can be either color or black and white.
6. **Print making:** The Print Making category includes relief printing, silk screening, intaglio, processed hard copy print, etc.
7. **3 Dimensional:** The 3-Dimensional category may be presented in one **or more** of the following mediums: clay, metals, wood, fibers, etc.
8. **Crafts:** The Crafts category includes crafts such as book arts, paper crafts, stained glass, fibers, etc..
9. **Traditional Cultural Art:** This category will include artwork of an ancestral technique to be indigenous to a specific culture, such as Native American beadwork, Norwegian woodcarving, Asian Batik, American quilt making, etc.
10. **Digital Media/ Graphic Design:** This category includes any artwork that is computer generated, such as logo work, poster design, artwork using design software, etc.
11. **2-Dimensional Mixed Media:** This category includes art work that employs

multiple media and/or collage that would not fit into a drawing or painting category and must have two or more mediums combined to create a finished product.

12. **Functional Ceramics:** This category will include containers and/or items that could have a functional use and are made of clay, plaster, or porcelain such as cups, bowls, vases, plates, bookends, and other such items. ***\*Functional Ceramics are not permitted in the 3D or Craft categories.***

Chad motioned, seconded by Dana, to approve the changes to Article 4, Section 2 of the Handbook. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Items for discussion only from the committee
  - a. Survey to be sent to judges to gather their feedback
  - b. Update instruction sheet on website. Have sawtooth hangers be placed above the top edge of the piece.
