Bob Kornely
COACH/DIRECTOR

Bob Kornely is a teacher and coach at Todd County High School in Mission, South Dakota where he has served for 30 years.

Kornely is a graduate of Todd County High School where he participated in football and track and field. After high school, Kornely went to college at Dakota Wesleyan University. It was here that he decided to go into education and coaching. At DWU he participated in football and track. He was a four-year starter, two time All Conference performer, Team Captain, and Lifter of the Year. At DWU he got his first coaching opportunity as a student assistant coach on the football team after his four years of eligibility were finished.

After graduating from college Kornely began his teaching career in 1993 at his alma mater, Todd County High School, working as a Social Studies teacher. During this time at Todd County, he started out as an assistant coach in both but became a Head Track Coach in 1997 and Head Football Coach in 2001.

In track and field, Todd County has won the region track and field championship six times and four consecutive LNI boys and girls championships with Kornely as head coach. He was the Region 4 Track Coach of the Year two times.

In football, Kornely is the school's all-time winningest coach – recording a 115-79 record as a head coach and has won over 150 games as a head and an assistant coach combined. He has coached 11 conference championships and coached the 2022 All Nations League Championship. Kornely was Region 7 Football Coach of the Year two times and coached in the South Dakota All Star game in 1993.

Kornely has been married to his wife, Carrie, for 29 years and has three children: Ryan (28) (wife Liz), Madison (24), and Jaycob (16). He has taught and coached all three of his kids at Todd County High School.

"I've been very fortunate as a coach to work with numerous other coaches and hundreds of student athletes. The relationships and experiences with them are what I value the most."

Since 1983 the National Federation Officials Association has sponsored Active Officials Awards for each state in all sports. South Dakota's football Awards program began in 1988. The individuals receiving these awards have exemplified the highest standards of ethical conduct and moral character and have been given the endorsement of the SDHSAA. They have made significant contributions to high school officiating in South Dakota and are members of the NFIOA. On behalf of the administrators, coaches, athletes, and the SDHSAA we salute these people for their outstanding service and unselfish devotion.

Scott Jacobson

Scott Jacobson has officiated high school football for 35 years. His officiating career began with an invitation from Dennis Krsnak to join his crew of South Dakota Army National Guardsmen, in Rapid City, in the late 80's. Scott worked with that crew for about 10 years before that crew retired and he became the crew chief in the late 90's. He continued the national guard tradition by asking several of his peers, including his brother Joe, to join him. That crew is still going strong and has worked five state championship games with the most recent being the 11AAA game in 2022.

Jacobson is honored to have worked with his same crew all these years and to be recognized in a recent article in the November 2023 issue of Referee magazine. The title of the article, Highest Ranked Crew, highlights each of the seven crew members (2 general officers, 4 colonels and 1 son of an E-8 master sergeant) with their service to country, and ties to community service by officiating high school football. Scott credits the crew's success to the strong relationships, trust, and respect they all have for one another and each official's desire to do the best job they can on Friday night.

Scott is grateful for the many friendships that have come from working with other officials throughout the state. He is very active in his community and enjoys supporting and mentoring new and young officials, coaches, and young players in various youth football programs in the Black Hills area. These include Black Hills Youth Football League, Rapid City Junior Football, and other various sub varsity programs around the area. He is honored to represent football officials across the state as he serves on the SDHSAA Sports Officials Advisory Council.

Scott is grateful to his wife Angel, and his children, for their support in his officiating all these years.

South Dakota sports fans were stunned in 1988 when Doug Koester of Pierre collapsed and died while officiating the 11B championship game here in the DakotaDome. Koester was a fine official, a devoted husband, a good father to his three children, and still had time to contribute to church and community activities.

In Memory of Doug, and in an effort to recognize the contributions that officials make, not only to high school sports but to their community as a whole, the South Dakota High School Officials Association has established an award to recognize a deserving official for his contributions. The 2023 recipient of this award is **Paul Ortman, Sioux Falls.**

Paul Ortman has devoted a part of his life to helping others and mentoring officials. Paul started officiating while attending the University of South Dakota and served as USD's coordinator of intramural officials in the 1980s and 90s. He thanks the many mentors who helped him get started, most notably Scott Fiedler and the late Colin Kapitan. Paul just completed his 45th year of high school football in South Dakota and thanks his fellow crewmates for their dedication, including Al Hansen and Steve Riswold, both have been on Paul's officiating crews for over 20 years. Paul is privileged to have officiated three state football championship games, two state basketball tournaments, and numerous state baseball tournaments. Paul is actively involved in mentoring young officials for South Dakota Junior Football. He is also a school bus driver and has a passion for both golf and as a church volunteer. The impact of his efforts will be felt for a long time by all who know him.

SDHSAA TOURNAMENT TEAM AND SPECTATOR CONDUCT RULES

The following rules apply to all district, region and state events. All member schools, conferences, etc. are encouraged to adopt these rules for all regular season contests.

A. Conduct of spectators, coaches and players.

- There must be sufficient planning, by the tournament manager and by all participating schools
 which have qualified for the tournament, relative to appropriate crowd control during the
 duration of the event.
- All participating schools will be expected to emphasize the necessity for proper crowd behavior.
 Administrators from member schools are expected to position themselves near their student cheering section whenever their team is playing.
- Coaches will be expected at all times to display the type of conduct which contributes good sportsmanship and which does not incite the spectators in attendance.
- Coaches will be expected to impress upon their athletes the importance of displaying good sportsmanship at all times, including players on the court, substitutes sitting on the bench, or following the conclusion of a game.
- Administrators will be expected to impress upon their coaches the importance of displaying good sportsmanship at all times.
- 6. All fans will be expected to remain off the playing area until after the awarding of medals and trophies. Failure to remain off the playing floor will result in the offending team not being recognized by the public address announcer. Medals and trophy will be awarded to school personnel following the awards ceremony. Fans will be allowed on the playing area following the presentation of all awards.

B. Equipment and facilities.

- Removal of the nets following the championship game will be under the direction and supervision of the tournament manager.
- The breaking of a backboard will become the financial liability of the school whose fan(s) caused the damage.
- Vandalism to locker room facilities, motel rooms, etc. shall be the responsibility of the member school whose player/team was responsible for the damage.

C. No banners - no signs - no noisemakers

- Temporary banners and signs of all kinds are prohibited except those displayed by the SDHSAA, the Association's corporate partners, the tournament band, the arena, the tournament manager, and licensed radio and television stations. Cheer cards displayed by cheerleaders are permissible.
- All types of noisemakers are prohibited. This includes plastic hand shakers, thunder sticks, as well as all sorts of projectiles.
- Paper confetti and silly string are prohibited.
- Balloons are prohibited.
- Megaphones are prohibited except when used by a cheerleader.
- Musical instruments are prohibited except when the band is performing.
- Stereo tape decks and related radio equipment are prohibited during official tournament play. (Host management may provide music that may be played during warm-ups, quarter and half-time breaks, or breaks in the action such as dead balls, etc.)

D. Hoops, mini-tramps and tunnels.

- The use of "break-through" hoops, mini-tramps, rebounding devices & related pieces of equipment is prohibited.
- 2. Human tunnels created by student and/or adult fans are prohibited.
- Pennants, Number 1 Fingers, Homer Hankies, Rooter Poms, etc. will be permitted.
- F. Laser Pointers are prohibited. If used, the laser pointers will be permanently confiscated.
- G. Re-Entry. As per local venue policy, individuals wishing to leave the venue during a session will receive a hand stamp/accommodation pass for re-admittance to the venue for that session only.
- H. Smoking is not allowed inside the venue. As per local venue policy, adult smokers will be given a hand stamp/accommodation pass for re-admittance to the venue for that session only.
- I. The management will designate each participating team's section of the bleachers.
- Students are asked not to stand on the seats. Students may stand in the foot wells in the student section.
- K. Jumping up and down in unison is prohibited.
- Adult cheerleaders are not permitted in the student cheering sections. However, adults will
 be permitted to sit in the student section if space allows.
- M. Cheerleaders, spirit or yell leaders will be allowed, provided they are so designated by their school and appear in a school approved uniform.
- N. All fans must wear shirts. Body paint is not allowed for either students or adults. Face paint is allowed.
- O. Face masks are prohibited.
- P. Gambling and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

SDHSAA ARENA RULES

The following rules and regulation are applicable to all venues hosting SDHSAA State Events:

- All fans must wear shirts.
- 2. Face masks are prohibited.
- 3. Fans are not prohibited from wearing face paint.
- 4. Human tunnels and/or break through hoops are prohibited.
- Signs, banners, and noisemakers are prohibited.

- Smoking inside the venue is not allowed. Adults wishing to smoke will be issued an accommodation pass or stamp to exit through a specific door and re-enter through said door.
- 7. Spectators must remain off the playing floor at all times.
- 8. No one is allowed to sit, stand or hang on the basket or the basket supports.
- 9. Students with bleacher tickets must use the facilities on the main floor.
- 10. The throwing of objects of any kind onto the playing floor in prohibited.
- Gambling or use of intoxicating beverages is not permitted in the arena. Anyone found indulging
 in either would be required to leave the building.
- 12. Laser pointers are prohibited and will be confiscated by meet management.
- 13. Jumping up and down on the bleachers, in unison, is prohibited.
- 14. All fans will be expected to remain off the playing floor until after the awarding of medals and trophies. Failure to remain off the playing floor will result in the offending team not being recognized by the public address announcer. Medals and trophy will be awarded to school personnel following the awards ceremony. Fans will be allowed on to the playing floor following the presentation of all awards.

NOTE: This policy is applicable to football, volleyball, and basketball.

DAMAGE TO BLEACHERS AT A STATE EVENT

Damage to bleachers can be caused when the entire student body jumps up and down in unison on the bleachers. The SDHSAA cannot condone or overlook behavior that causes physical damage to a rented yearse.

Therefore, the SDHSAA suggests the following:

- Member schools should prohibit this type of behavior from occurring at all regular season contests.
- District and region committees should prohibit this type of behavior from occurring at all district and region tournaments.
- All member schools that qualify a team to a state tournament should make an announcement at a pep assembly informing the student body that this type of behavior is prohibited by the SDHSAA.
- All member schools should solicit the support and leadership of the cheerleaders to stop this behavior.
- Administrators from each of the participating schools should position themselves in close proximity
 to the student cheering section so they can immediately assist management to stop the jumping if
 and when it occurs.
