FACILITY INFORMATION:

Koehler Hall of Fame Field is the preeminent softball stadium in the Upper Midwest and one of the finest NCAA Division II facilities in the entire country. Named in honor of a generous lead gift from NSU alumnus Jim Koehler, the Field consists of an all-synthetic turf field, in-ground dugouts, bullpens and batting cages, chair back seating, and a media / suite area directly behind home plate. The facility officially opened in the fall of 2021. Restrooms are located in the concessions building down the third base line.

- Parking is available in the Koehler HOF, Dacotah Bank Stadium, and Barnett Center lots
- Pets are not permitted in the facility unless they are a certified service animal
- Gum and sunflower seeds are not permitted in the facility
- Metal spikes are NOT ALLOWED players are permitted to wear molded cleats, tennis shoes, or turf shoes
- Outside food is not permitted, both on the playing surface and in the bullpen areas
- · Coolers and bag chairs are not permitted
- On field hitting for warm-ups requires a turf hitting mat (located in the first base dugout)
- Teams are permitted to run dynamic warm-ups, throwing, and tee hitting in to Bownets on the Dacotah Bank Stadium field - front toss and infield/outfield are NOT ALLOWED
- Fans must remain in the Koehler Hall of Fame Field confines access to Dacotah Bank Stadium and the field is not permitted (aside from scheduled team warm-ups for players and team personnel ONLY)
- · Concessions will be available through the 4th inning of the last game of each day
