

Match Format and Scoring

Outdoors:

Championship round matches (excluding semi final and final round)	2 out of 3 sets – with match tie-break in lieu of deciding set
Championship matches (semi final and final round)	Full 2 out of 3 sets, no ad scoring
3 rd place through 5 th place matches (includes 5 th place semis)	10 game pro-set with a 7 point tie break when 9 all is reached – no ad scoring
Consolation matches	10 game pro set with a 7 point tie break when 9 all is reached – no ad scoring

Indoors: Format is subject to change due to weather conditions and will be mutually decided by the Meet Director and SDHSAA.

Note – Additional matches (3rd, 5th, consolation) may be played indoors if time permits and courts are available.

Championship round matches	2 out of 3 with match tie-break in lieu of the deciding set
Consolation matches	8 game pro-set with 7 point tie break when 7 all is reached – no ad scoring

*Set tie-break (1st to 7, win by 2)

**Match tie-break (1st to 10, win by 2)

When moving from indoor back to outdoor tennis, the same format as used indoors will be used until the entire round has been completed at a specific flight.
