## POST MATCH PROTOCOL AT REGION/STATE VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENTS

Read the following:

Only team personnel are allowed on the floor immediately following all region, and state championship contests in the sports of volleyball.

Spectators will be allowed on the floor only after team handshakes for contests with no awards, or following the presentation of individual and team awards.

Failure to keep fans/spectators off the floor until after the awards have been presented will result in the offending team not receiving public recognition at the tournament site. Individual and team awards will be given to a member of the offending team and the team will not be announced by the public address announcer at the tournament venue.
