The Board of Directors held a regular meeting on June 10, 2021, at the SDHSAA Office Building in Pierre, South Dakota with members present as follows:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Craig Cassens at 8:34 A.M., followed by the pledge of allegiance.

APPENDIX A

2021-22 NFHS Rulebook Exceptions: SDHSAA

*(PR)- Playing Rule

*(AR)- Administrative Rule

Deviations in Playing Rule render the state ineligible for membership on the NFHS Rules Committee for that sport.

Basketball:

- Some varsity play permitted in halves (PR).
- Allow multiple manufacturer's logos/trademarks on visible undergarments with a logo maximum restriction of 2 ½ x 2 ½ (PR).
- Allow all sublimated or printed logos around the collar of the undershirt (PR).

Track and Field:

- Distance for girls 100M hurdles (PR)
 - o Start to 1st hurdle- 13m
 - o Distance between hurdles-8m
 - o Last hurdle to finish- 15m

Volleyball:

• Pre-wrap is not allowed as a headband and/or hair control device. Headbands, if worn, must be black, white, or the predominant color similar to that of the torso of the uniform (excluding the libero) and must be the same for all participants (AR).

Wrestling:

- Allow third person in wrestler's corner during tournaments (must be a student manager)(PR).
- Allow 30 minutes of wrestling as opposed to 5 matches (PR).
