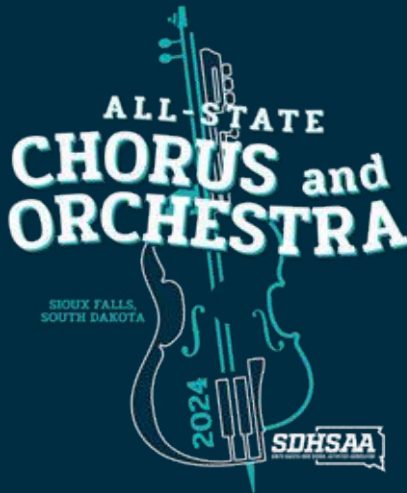

##### 2. Initiate a Claim:

- Review your claimed properties
- Enter your information and verify your address
- Click "Submit" to officially create your claim

##### 3. Complete Your Claim:

- Check your email for a message with a claim form attached. (It may go to your spam/junk).
- Review and gather required documentation.
- Submit documents to the State by uploading them using the portal on the claims website or mail copies to SD State Treasurer-UCP, 124 E Dakota Ave, Pierre, SD 57501.

## Guest Orchestra Conductor

# Dr. Luis Viquez

Latin Grammy-nominated and American Prize winner artist **Luis Viquez** continues to gain attention as one of the most influential Central American musicians of his generation with his versatile career as a clarinetist and orchestral, opera, and wind band conductor. A native of Costa Rica, he currently serves as the Director of Orchestral Studies and Assistant Professor of Orchestral Conducting at the University of Rhode Island. Prior to this, he held an acclaimed seven-year tenure as the Director of Orchestral Activities Endowed Chair and Music Director of the University of South Dakota Symphony Orchestra, as well as the conductor of the University of South Dakota Opera from 2016 to 2023. Under Dr. Viquez's guidance, the orchestral program at the University of South Dakota earned both national and international acclaim as one of the most vibrant institutions for orchestral studies in the Midwest region. He also served as USD's Associate Professor of Clarinet, leading a successful studio comprising both graduate and undergraduate Music Education and Music Performance students, several of them winning prestigious awards at the state and regional level.



As a sought-after guest conductor, Dr. Viquez has led featured performances throughout the United States, Costa Rica, Honduras, Guatemala, and England, collaborating with ensembles such as the Orquesta Sinfónica de Heredia (Costa Rica), the Cartago Municipal Orchestra (Costa Rica), the National Wind Orchestra of Guatemala, the Cherokee Symphony (IA), the Emporia Symphony Orchestra (KS), the Midwest Chamber Ensemble (KS), the Cartago National Wind Ensemble (Costa Rica), and the Hastings Symphony (NE). Recently, he held conducting fellowships with the Allentown Symphony Orchestra (PA), the Saratoga Orchestra (WA), and the Chamber Orchestra of New York.

Parallel to his career as a conductor, Dr. Viquez is an accomplished clarinetist. He has appeared as a soloist with the South Dakota Symphony, the Cherokee Symphony, the Sioux City Municipal Band, and the Heredia Symphony. In the early years of his career, he served as a member of the National Symphony Orchestra of Costa Rica and toured with the World Youth Wind Orchestra in Taiwan. His performances can be heard on the albums "Eddie Mora: Haikus" and "Paul Lombardi: Music for Clarinet and Other Instruments," as well as on four albums in which he recorded as the principal clarinetist of the Heredia Symphony Orchestra released by Musica Records. He has also performed live for the South Dakota Public Broadcasting, the Iowa Public Radio, and the University of Costa Rica Broadcasting System.

As an avid champion for Music Education and community music, Dr. Viquez is a highly demanded clinician and adjudicator at the national and international level. As a scholar, Dr. Viquez has published academic articles, both in English and Spanish, regarding instrumental music pedagogy and Latin American music.

He is a winner of the 2022 American Prize in Orchestral Performance, in addition of being one of the recipients of the 2021 South Dakota Music Education Association Outstanding Educator Award and the 2022 University of South Dakota Presidential Legacy Award. He also received an Honorable Mention in the 2022 Respighi Prize in Orchestral Conducting, organized by the City of Bologna and the Chamber Orchestra of New York. Dr. Viquez holds degrees from the University of Costa Rica (BM – Clarinet Performance), Truman State University (MA – Clarinet Performance & MA – Wind Band Conducting), and the Conservatory of Music at the University of Missouri Kansas City (DMA – Orchestral & Opera Conducting). He is a clarinet artist for the brands Royal Global Clarinets and D'Addario Woodwinds USA and currently serves as the National Vice President of the College Orchestra Directors Association.

# All-State Orchestra Personnel

The members of the South Dakota All-State Orchestra are selected each fall by competitive auditions at three sites around the state. A full symphony orchestra is then selected from among the best musicians in South Dakota.

This year's orchestra has 159 musicians representing 30 schools.

# *Dr. Michael Hanawalt*

**Michael Hanawalt** is the Associate Professor of Choral Conducting and Music Education at Florida State University, where he conducts the Chamber Choir, teaches graduate courses in conducting and choral literature, and serves as Artistic Director for the Tallahassee Community Chorus. Dr. Hanawalt was a founding member of the professional male vocal ensemble Cantus, serving as both its Executive Director and singing as part of the touring ensemble.



Throughout his tenure with the organization, he recorded 12 CDs and performed in or oversaw the booking of over 500 concerts, including collaborations with the King's Singers, the Boston Pops, the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, and the Minnesota Orchestra. Dr. Hanawalt is active as a tenor soloist and has won competitions sponsored by the Schubert Club and Thursday Musical. Recent solo performances include Mozart's Requiem at Tarleton State University (TX) and Westfield State University (MA), Evangelist in Bach's Matthäus-Passion at the Bethany College Messiah Festival of the Arts, and Beethoven's Ninth Symphony with the Wichita Symphony Orchestra. He regularly serves as guest conductor for honor choirs, and his choral arrangements are published by Boosey & Hawkes,

the Niel A. Kjos Music Company, and Colla Voce. Dr. Hanawalt holds the BM in Vocal Performance from St. Olaf College, the MM in Choral Conducting from Michigan State University, and the PhD in Choral Music Education from Florida State University.

**Joel Van Peursem** is the director of bands at Mitchell Middle School where he directs the jazz band and drum line in addition to the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade bands. Joel is originally from Vermillion, South Dakota and attended Northwestern College in Orange City, Iowa where he received his bachelor's degrees in Music and Secondary Education. He is The Coordinating Music Director for the Mitchell Municipal Band. He is a member of SDMEA and South Dakota Band Masters and participates in hosting all-state jazz and all state band for the middle school for the past few years. This past February Joel was awarded the SD Band Masters Young Director of the Year Award and is very honored to be receiving the SDMEA Young Music Educator Award tonight. In his free time, he teaches private lessons and loves spending time with his wife Kaitlyn, daughter Cecelia, and their dog Coda.
