

WHAT TO BRING

Congratulations on deciding to attend the SDSCA Middle School State Student Council Convention!

The following is a suggested list of clothing and other items you may want to bring along with you to the State Convention.

Shirts for the Convention:

- *Tuesday* has been named as “School Spirit Day” Students and advisors should wear a shirt with their school colors.
- *Wednesday* wear your convention shirt

Other Clothing:

School clothes: Jeans, comfortable shoes and a sweatshirt.

PLEASE LEAVE AT HOME-Hats, baseball caps, etc: We will not allow caps, headbands, bandannas or any headwear (unless it is for religious reasons) to be worn inside the building during the convention.

Delegates should not bring any clothing that is offensive or questionable in nature. Each Convention delegate is a school leader and we expect them to live up to their leadership responsibilities. Please follow school policies when determining what to wear at the convention

Banquet clothes for Tuesday evening: This is a “dress up” event! Suit, sport coat with dress shirt and tie or a nice polo for guys; and skirt and blouse, pant suit or dress for ladies.

Clothes for Tuesday evening activities (Dance): Students are to adhere to their local school dress code. Students dressed inappropriately will not be permitted into the dance.

Money: For snacks you might pick up or items to purchase at the dance.

School supplies: A spiral notebook, pencils, pens, marking pens, scissors, tape, poster paper and other materials. (To take notes or to prepare for election campaigns- posters). Talk to your advisor.

Medications: Any prescription and over the counter medicine you may need during the convention. All medications must be in original or properly labeled containers.

Bring lots of enthusiasm, an eagerness to try new ideas, and a desire to meet new people and to learn! Most importantly bring a positive attitude!
