

WHAT TO BRING

Congratulations on deciding to attend the State Student Council Convention! The following is a suggested list of clothing and other items you may want to bring along with you to the State Convention.

Clothing:

School clothes: Jeans, comfortable shoes and a sweatshirt.

Hats, baseball caps, etc: PLEASE LEAVE THEM AT HOME. We will not allow caps, headbands, bandannas or any headwear (unless it is for religious reasons) to be worn inside the Rushmore Theatre during the presentations.

Delegates should not bring any clothing that is offensive or questionable in nature. Each Convention delegate is a school leader and we expect them to live up to their leadership responsibilities.

Banquet clothes: This is a "dress up" event! Suit or sport coat with dress shirt and tie for guys; and skirt and blouse, or dress for ladies. Let's try to look our best!

Clothes for Monday evening activities (Dance): Students are to adhere to their local school dress code. Students dressed inappropriately will not be permitted into the dance or other activities.

State Board Candidates: Please try to dress nice for the candidate interviews and candidate speeches. A professional look goes a long way!!!

Money: For Tuesday evening; plus money for any snacks.

School supplies: A spiral notebook, pencils, pens, marking pens, scissors, tape, poster paper and other materials. (To take notes and prepare for election campaigns).

Medications: Any prescription and over the counter medicine you may need during the convention. **All** medications must be in original or properly labeled containers.

Optional: Cameras to take pictures and preserve memories.
