A school may have unlimited entries in each instrumental and vocal ensemble event, however there must be entirely different personnel in each of the entries for an event (i.e. if entering two "Woodwind Choirs" each choir must have entirely different personnel).

Vocal, Band and Orchestra Ensemble Student Entries Are Limited As Follows:

- A. Band students may not enter more than three ensembles and/or choirs. (This would not include members in stage band or jazz band).
- B. Vocal students may not enter more than three ensembles and/or groups. (This would not include members in show choir or jazz choir.)
- C. Orchestra students may not enter more than three orchestra ensembles and/or groups.
- D. Students accompanying solos and /or ensembles may be entered as a soloist or be a member of ensemble a maximum total of 10 events plus accompany a maximum 5 additional events.

NOTE: A student may not be entered in more than a maximum total of 10 Vocal & Instrumental Solos/Ensembles (a student accompanist can be entered in 10 events and accompany a maximum 5 additional events). The ten event limit applies even if the Vocal Solo/Ensemble Contest is held on a separate date from the Instrumental Solo/Ensemble Contest.
