DETERMINING ZERO POINT FOR POLE VAULT STANDARDS Updated February 2025

- 1. Front buns must be removed first.
- 2. Base of standards shall be placed so that zero point of uprights is at top of the back of plant box.
- 3. Two people should extend a string/twine along zero point so the standards on each side begin at zero point. The string/twine should intersect the plant box at top of the back.
- 4. Place cross bar at a low height so that a person standing on the landing pad can reach over it.
- 5. Hang a plumb-bob over the cross bar. It should touch the top of the back of the plant box.
- 6. This procedure should be followed for the practice, as well as meets.
- 7. Place a permanent extended line, ½" or 1 cm wide, drawn through the top zero point extending up to 10' (3 meters) on each side of the box.
