## MARKING SECTOR FOR SHOT PUT AND DISCUS Updated February 2025

For all meets, the 34.92-degree sector must be used for both the Shot Put and Discus.

To mark the 34.92-degree sector:

From the center of the circle, mark off a boundary of 20 yards (A) and make a mark (#1). .6 of A From that mark, measure toward the other outer boundary line a distance of 12 yards (0.6 x 20 yards) and make another mark (#2). From the center of the circle, measure the other outer boundary line 20 yards (A). Align mark (#2) with this measurement. The result is a 34.92degree throwing sector.
