

Regional Representatives Responsibilities

Regional Representatives shall be appointed by the Board of Directors for a three-year term, consistent with the provisions of the SDCCTFOA Constitution.

Regional Representatives are members of the Board of Directors for the SDCCTFOA.

A SDCCTFOA Regional Representative is responsible for all the territory and officials listed within their regional boundaries and identified in the SDCCTFOA Constitution. Regional Reps will interact with and communicate with the officials in their region and are responsible for their inquiries and requests.

Regional Reps are responsible for conducting one in person meeting in their region for the purpose of conducting an in-person clinic. Topics for the clinic will be identified by the Board of Directors of the SDCCTFOA and a lesson plan/agenda will be developed by the board. The clinic will be conducted by either a designated clinician or by the Regional Rep, as appropriate.

Regional Reps may be tasked with additional duties or responsibilities by the Board of Directors as needed.
