SPORTSMANSHIP & TOURNAMENT CONDUCT:

All school administrators and coaches of participating schools in the SDHSAA State Basketball Tournament are expected to help demonstrate and regulate behavior to model a positive approach. School administrators accompanying their team and fan sections to the State Tournament should review the section on Arena Fan Conduct Rules as listed in the General Sports Information section of the SDHSAA Handbook prior to the State Tournament, and be expected to help keep fan sections in compliance with these regulations.

VIDEOTAPING POLICY:

EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT:

Teams will be reimbursed based upon the guidelines as adopted by the SDHSAA Board of Directors. This reimbursement listing can be found in the General Sports Information section of the SDHSAA Handbook.

TEAM ROSTER:

Team rosters will be utilized from those posted on SDHSAA website after the conclusion of Region Tournaments. If you have any changes or additions to this roster, please be sure to indicate those to Tournament Management as soon as possible.

TICKETS FOR PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS:

For each school that qualifies for the State Tournament, the following tickets will be provided to you, free of charge:

- Eight All-Tournament Tickets for use by school administration (mailed to schools)
- Twenty contestant passes for use by players and student managers
- Six passes for coaches, bus drivers and statisticians
- Passes for cheerleaders will be provided, up to a maximum of eight

Any additional passes, if needed, must be purchased by the school through the normal fan entrances.

There will be no restrictions on fan attendance during the event, however NO REENTRY will be allowed in/out of the arena except for the most extenuating circumstances.

OFFICIAL BALL:

The official ball of the SDHSAA State Basketball Championships is the Baden Perfection Elite Pro. Host sites will be provided with enough balls for use during the tournament; teams do not need to bring their own for warm-ups or practice.

FCA DINNER:

There will be no FCA Dinner this year.

SPIRIT OF SU:

Each year the Spirit of Su award is given to an outstanding senior player who exemplifies the life of SuAnne Big Crow of Pine Ridge. SuAnne was killed in a car accident on her way to the Miss Basketball Banquet in 1992. The application form is available on the SDHSAA website; coaches are encouraged to nominate one of their senior players for this award. Applications should be turned in during Wednesday's coaches meeting.

AWARDS:

All awards for teams and individuals will be presented immediately following the conclusion of each game of the tournament on Saturday. A designated area for pictures and fan greetings will be provided that will specifically be 'off of the playing surface' to allow following games to continue.

The family of SuAnne Big Crow will present the "Spirit of Su" award to an outstanding senior basketball player.

The SDHSAA will award four team trophies and four plaques as well as twenty individual medals will be given to each team. No individuals will be announced; awards will be presented team-by-team.
