SDHSAA STATE STUDENT COUNCIL CONVENTION

The 32nd Annual State Student Council Convention was held at the Denny Sanford PREMIER Center in Sioux Falls, April 7-8. A total of 981 students and advisors attended from 69 high schools across the state.

Focusing on the theme "Lighting the Future", the Convention utilized a combination of breakout sessions and large group instructional presentations. Guest speaker for the convention was Sam Otto from the SD Army ROTC. The keynote speaker was motivational speaker and stand-up comedian, Matt Bellace.

The convention also featured a state-wide community service project, which made 72 fleece blankets to donate to SD & NE flood victims.

Convention activities included the annual business meeting of the SDSCA and the election of the Association's 2019-2020 state officers, as well as the election of the officers for each of the Association's seven regions.

"SOUTH DAKOTA WARREN E. SHULL STUDENT COUNCIL ADVISOR OF THE YEAR"

The "Warren E. Shull Student Council Advisor of The Year Award" is named after Warren E. Shull, who founded the National Association of Student Councils (NASC) while he was a high school student council president.
