The 2004 High School Press Convention was held on the SDSU campus in Brookings on October 11. Over 257 high school journalists and their advisors from 31 schools attended the convention.

During the day, both the students and advisors were involved in a variety of activities and workshops. The sessions covered the various phases of journalistic activity involving newspapers, yearbooks and photography. Presenters for the convention included Bobby Hawthorne, author of books on reporting and writing for student publications, Gary Lundgren, editor of Jostens Advisor & Staff magazine and members of the SDSU Journalism Department Staff.

The Convention activities concluded with the "General Session". This session included the announcement of the results for the "On-the-Spot" contests, the "First Edition" newspaper contest and Annual Publications Contest for Newspapers, Yearbooks and Literary Publications. The members of the SDHSAA Journalism Advisory Committee presented the awards to all the winning entries.

FOUNDER'S AWARD WINNER

The 2004 Founder's Award was presented to Jan Johnson, during the annual High School Press Convention on October 11, 2004. The Founders Award is presented annually in recognition of outstanding service to high school journalism through teaching the principles of good journalism.

Jan Johnson was formerly the newspaper advisor at Estelline High School prior to her moving to Watertown where she teaches English on a part-time basis at Watertown High School. At Estelline High School, Johnson she taught for 27 years and served as the school's newspaper advisor for 18 years. When she first began working as the Estelline newspaper advisor, one of Johnson's goals was to turn the newspaper into an award-winning publication. Under her guidance, the *EHS Informer* received 13 All-State awards including All-State designations for each year from 1995-2003.

From 1999 to 2003 Johnson served as a member of the SDHSAA Journalism Advisory Committee. As a member of the Journalism Advisory Committee she helped determine many of the regulations for high school publications competition which are used today.
