SDSCA ANNUAL STATE CONVENTION

The South Dakota Student Council Association's 27th Annual State Convention was held at the Ramkota RiverCentre in Pierre, March 30th – April 1st. A record 860 students and advisors attended from 61 high schools across the state.

Focusing on the theme "E.S.P.N.- Fit for Life", the SDSCA Convention utilized a combination of breakout sessions and large group instructional presentations. The keynote speakers for the convention were Mr. Dusty Johnson, Governor Daugaard's Chief of Staff, and John Beede, one of the top youth, college, and corporate motivational speakers and trainers in the world.

The convention also featured a state-wide community service project, which made 59 fleece blankets to disperse among communities throughout the state. The goal of the project is for the blankets to be given to women/children shelters, hospitals, and nursing homes to aid those who need some help.

Convention activities included the annual business meeting of the SDSCA and the election of the Association's 2014-2015 state officers, as well as the election of the officers for each of the Association's seven regions.
