The 31st Annual State Student Council Convention was held at the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center in Rapid City, March 25th-26th. A total of 1028 students and advisors attended from 73 high schools across the state.

Focusing on the theme "Hometown Heroes", the Convention utilized a combination of breakout sessions and large group instructional presentations. Guest speaker for the convention was LTC Elvis Coronado from the SD Army ROTC. The keynote speaker was motivational speaker, consultant, ambassador, and author, Mike Smith.

The convention also featured a 3k Charity Run which raised over \$2000. The goal of the project was to give all proceeds to the muscular dystrophy association.
