## **SDHSAA STATE STUDENT COUNCIL CONVENTION**

The 2021-22 State Student Council Convention was held at the Monument in Rapid City on April 3-4, 2022. A total of 931 students and advisors from 61 different schools were in attendance.

Focusing on the theme of “Represent, Rebuild, Reconnect”, the convention consisted of multiple keynote presentations from speakers David Edward Garcia, Jessie Funk, and Juan Bendana. The Army ROTC co-sponsored the convention.

Schools raised over \$26,000 that was donated to the Children’s Miracle Network. Schools also donated various needed items that were donated to homeless shelters in different areas of the state.

Convention activities included the annual business meeting of the SDSCA and the election of the 2022-23 SDSCA State Board Officers.

### **"SOUTH DAKOTA WARREN E. SHULL STUDENT COUNCIL ADVISOR OF THE YEAR"**
