## **SDHSAA STATE STUDENT COUNCIL CONVENTION**

The 2022-23 State Student Council Convention was held at the Monument in Rapid City on March 28-29, 2023. A total of 1002 students and advisors from 70 different schools were in attendance.

Focusing on the theme of “Reaching for the Stars”, the convention consisted of multiple keynote presentations from speakers Jason Michaels and Deb Hult.

Schools raised over \$22,000 that was donated to the Children’s Miracle Network.

Convention activities included the annual business meeting of the SDSCA and the election of the 2022-23 SDSCA State Board Officers.

### **"SOUTH DAKOTA WARREN E. SHULL STUDENT COUNCIL ADVISOR OF THE YEAR"**
